2018-19 Indoor Percussion Season

Dear Parents and Students,

Welcome to the 2018-19 season of the Ontario High School Indoor Percussion! The percussion staff has been working many hours to provide an exciting and more competitive show this year. We are very excited to present this year's show: *The Nature of Sound*.

Ontario High School competes in the *Southern California Percussion Alliance* (SCPA) circuit. With over 50 groups in our division, A class is the most competitive division in SCPA. Only the top 12 groups in A class will advance to finals. Being in this division requires a strong commitment from our students, parents, and staff. Regular after-school rehearsals will start the week after Thanksgiving break and continue through the end of March 2019. We will also have several all-day Saturday rehearsals throughout the season. Please remember that students must arrive at least 15 minutes early to every rehearsal for set-up, and they will need at least 15 minutes after every rehearsal for clean-up. Floor painting is scheduled during the month of January 2019 after winter break (*weather permitting*). We will compete in three regular season competitions and championship prelims/finals. Please remember that students are responsible for finding their own rides to and from each competition. An itinerary for each competition will be handed out and posted one week before the event. At the end of our season, we will have our 2nd annual Spring Showcase in the OHS gym. A complete season schedule can be found on page 4.

The percussion staff has set high standards for its students and expects students to uphold these standards throughout the entire indoor percussion season. **Students must conduct themselves in a professional manner and treat their staff, school, and fellow percussionists with respect.** Students will learn professionalism, how to work in a team-environment, and the responsibility of making a commitment to one's team. **Students are also responsible for bringing the required materials to every rehearsal (music, binders, water, etc.).** The percussion staff continues to push these standards year after year so that we may offer a better overall experience for the parents and students.

It requires many hours of hard work and dedication to have a successful indoor percussion season. By joining the OHS indoor percussion program, students are making a commitment to themselves and to the group for the entire season. OHS 2018-19 Indoor Percussion Season – Fair Share Contribution

The Ontario High School Music Boosters is a non-profit organization that works year-round to raise the funds necessary to run a successful band program. Ontario High School offers several programs for its students including: marching band, concert band, indoor percussion, and winter guard. Each year the music boosters are successful in funding these programs; however, doing so requires a very large budget. Below is an approximate breakdown of this year's expenses to show parents and students what it costs to run just the indoor percussion program:

» Competition Entry fees:	\$1,000
» Music Writing Fees:	\$1,000
» Staff Payroll:	\$6,500
» Rental Trucks:	\$825
» Floor Painting/Props:	\$425
» Equipment Repair:	\$250

Although the OHS Music Boosters work very hard to provide these programs for its students, they cannot do it without the support of the parents and students. Fair share contributions and fundraisers make up the majority of funds necessary to run the program. OHS 2018-19 Indoor Percussion Season – Costume Order Form


Each season the percussion staff finds ways to provide creative and professional costumes at a minimal cost to the student.
