

A SUCCESSFUL SEASON STARTS AT HOME

Every member of the OHS Entertainment Corps wants to have a successful season; but success does not come without hard work and dedication throughout the season. This is an advanced performance ensemble and we have high expectations of all of our members. You can help us succeed! Here's how:

- Be informed: check the website/calendar weekly, attend parent meetings.
- Make sure your student is early and prepared for ALL rehearsals and performances.
 - There is no excuse for missing an event, and missing even a single student affects the way the music sounds, and the choreography on the field. It holds the entire group back.
 - Check the student handbook for materials required for rehearsal.
- Make sure your student is practicing **Daily**.
 - When students show up to rehearsal with their music/choreography learned (lower order skills), we can work on musicality and visual highlights (higher order skills).
- Make sure your student is signing up for, practicing for, and taking their memorization tests. This is the main predictor of our seasonal scores!
- Encourage your student to work hard through challenges, do not let them quit when it gets difficult.
- Be visible.
 - Your students love it when you come and see their hard work! Our final rehearsal run through is open for you to see! Come to a football game, come to a tournament!
- Volunteer when you can.
 - This is a large program with a lot of working parts. When we have parents on deck ready to lend a hand it lets our teachers and staff do what they're meant to do: teach your students. See our volunteer page for more information!

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS AND OPTIONS

Each year we undertake 6 tournaments, 5 football games, 2 Saturday rehearsals, 2 concerts, 4 drum line shows, and 6 winter guard shows in addition to the fundraising we do. It takes a great deal of man power to get the students and their equipment on location, and keep an eye on them. We do ask that every household volunteer for **one** event during the course of the year.

Bus Chaperone	10-12 hours, entrance to event provided
Loading/Unloading the Truck	1-12 hours, entrance to event provided if staying for the entire event
Truck Driving	10-12 hours, no special license required. Entrance to event provided
Providing Snacks/Water	1 hour
Stands Chaperone	2-4 hours, entrance to event provided
Uniform Fitting	1-3 hours
Clean Up (post event)	1 hour
Sports Ticket Sales	2 hours
Football Snack Bar	5 hours
Concert Chaperone	2 Hours

CARE OF THE MARCHING BAND UNIFORM

At the end of each marching season we do ask that you take your students uniform to be dry cleaned.

- The cost is approximately \$20 and will help maintain the life of our uniforms.
- Please have your student hang their uniform in their garment bag after the final tournament (in November) and take it home to be cleaned.
- All uniforms must be returned to the band room the week after Thanksgiving break
- Any students using their uniform for drum major competitions in the Spring must dry clean their uniform and return it by the last regular week of school (in May).
